Notes:

The double-major option reduces the number of credits from 36 to 27, with the reduction in hours all coming from the electives. Students take 3 hours of American History electives rather than 6, 3 hours of non-American History electives rather than 6, and 3 hours of diversity electives rather than 6. For both majors and double majors, diversity electives can also be satisfied with American History and non-American History electives.
