Revisions to the timelines and requirements of the capstone process were initiated with the 2012-2013 incoming cohort (who are in the 2015-2016 graduating cohort reported above) and have resulted in significantly improved on-time completion rates.

***For two of these mandatory reporting years, the AuD cohort was smaller than typical. The AuD program at USD typically is capped at 5 students per year to allow for maximum student/faculty ratio, additional supervised clinical opportunities, and research mentoring.**

****During the 2015-2016 reporting cycle, a total of 7 students graduated, two of whom were part of previous cohorts and completed their requirements (e.g., capstone) during this reporting period.**
