USD at the University Center offers the Doctor of Education (Ed.D.) with the next cohort beginning in May 2009.

The leadership program is appropriate for:

- 1) Pre K-12 administrators who desire greater responsibility and marketability.
- 2) Administrators in higher education.
- 3) Those who teach adult learners in educational and non-educational setting.

The University of South Dakota and South Dakota State University collaborate to bring this program to the University Center. Each course will be delivered face-to-face in Sioux Falls on 4 Saturdays over 2 months supplemented by online instruction. Students study one course at a time and complete 2 courses each semester.

There are two emphases – either Adult and Higher Education or Pre K-12 administration.

Admission to the program requires the submission of application materials, official copies of transcripts providing proof of completion of both undergraduate and graduate degrees, three letters of recommendation, and recent scores on the Graduate Record Exam (GRE) or Miller Analogy test (MAT).
