A minimum of 36 hours in English including ENGL 101; 201; 203; 210; 221; 222; 241; 242; 284; 431 or 432; 489; LING 403, 425 or 443, and SEED 424. Allied requirements are LIBM 406 and 6 hours of speech.

Note: Students must have an academic teaching minor including a methods course. SPCM minor could be achieved by taking SPCM 101, 201, 203, 281/381, 405 and SEED 424. **A different minor will add a minimum of 6 hours.

The bachelor's degree is also available through the College of Arts and Sciences. The BA option will require an additional 6 hours of electives, 3 of those at the 400 level (ENGL 101 and 210 do not count towards the A & S English major). All teacher certification requirements must be completed including required scores on the PPST, Praxis content test 10041, and the PLT.
