A Health teaching minor may be achieved with the following courses: HLTH 103, 201, 250, 300, 320, 422, and 461. A Coaching minor may be achieved with ALHS 250, PE 271, 354, 350/450, 353/454, and a coaching class in one or more sports.

NOTE: Students must have an Academic Teaching Minor including a methods course. Course credits may not be double counted as both major and minor credits.

The Physical Education Bachelor's degree is only available through the School of Education. All teacher certification requirements must be completed including passing scores on the PPST, Praxis content exam 10091 and the PLT  
As a professionally accredited unit, the USD School of Education limits the number of students admitted to the Teacher Education programs based on the availability of resources.
