History

Herman E. Crowl, from Milbank, SD, was a Sergeant in Company H, 3rd Infantry. He served in the Philippines during the Spanish-American War.

Scope and Content Note

The single **Correspondence** series consists of letters that Crowl wrote to his sister in Olivet, SD, Verna Crowl Dickerson, while serving in the Philippines. He discusses his experiences in procuring supplies, his work as Post Quartermaster Sergeant and Sergeant Major, and discusses a revival in Manila.
