### **Scope and Content Note**

The collection, created by Allan H. Schell, chiefly contains political pins, buttons, posters, pennants, and ephemera related to U.S. presidential campaigns. Campaign buttons and pins comprise most of the collection and serve as a visual record of the presidential elections between 1884 and 2004. From the campaign of Grover Cleveland in 1884 to the primary race in 2000, the extensive collection includes political pins and buttons of presidential candidates from the Republican, Democratic and third parties. In addition to buttons and pins of presidential campaigns, the collection includes campaign memorabilia related to South Dakota politics in the 20<sup>th</sup> century.

The collection is organized into the Publications, Political Pins, Non-Political Pins, Political Memorabilia series.

**Political Pins Series, 1884-2000 (13 boxes, 13.0 linear ft.)**

Series contains nearly one thousand pins, buttons, and ribbons that date from the 1884 presidential election to the 2000 presidential primaries. The bulk of the buttons and pins relate to the elections between 1932 and 1996; thus remain as artifacts from the campaigns of Franklin D. Roosevelt, Dwight D. Eisenhower, Harry Truman, John F. Kennedy, Lyndon Baines Johnson, Richard Nixon, Jimmy Carter, Ronald Reagan, George H.W. Bush, and William J. Clinton. The collection includes numerous buttons and pins from the campaigns of candidates who did not receive either the Republican or Democratic nominations, as well as third party candidates. Other political pins include South Dakota gubernatorial candidates such as Richard Kneip, Bill Janklow, Joe Foss, and Nils Boe.

The series is organized chronologically. Items within the series are arranged in the following manner: Each box is separated into trays and each tray contains compartments containing one or more pins and buttons associated with the candidates. The box-by-box listing of the pins and buttons has two elements that serve to locate items related to individual candidates.

These elements are:

- A summary of each tray that lists the candidates, campaign year(s), running mates, political party, and the number of pins in the box associated with each candidate.
- A tray compartment list that, in detail, identifies each candidate and the number of pins associated with the candidate. Compartments are numbered.

Boxes 1-10 and 15 contain U.S. presidential candidate buttons and pins. Boxes 11-13 contain oversize items from the presidential campaigns between 1960 and 2000. All items are in chronological order.

Box 14 chiefly contains items related to South Dakota political races.
