Transportation information: Vermillion is located on South Dakota Highway 50, six miles west of the interchange with I-29, which runs north and south between Omaha, Sioux City, Sioux Falls and Fargo. I-29 is accessible from I-80, which runs east and west from Chicago to San Francisco, and I-90, which runs east and west from Chicago to Seattle.

Air service is available on Northwest, United, Delta, Southwest, and Allegiant Air, into Sioux Falls (1 hour drive) and Sioux City (45-minute drive), where rental cars are available. Omaha (2-hour drive) is also an option.
