THE SUMMER 2012 UNIVERSITY PROGRAM Applications DUE March 1, 2012

ADMISSION REQUIREMENTS

Admission requirements for the Summer University Program of The Indian University of North America, a partnership between Crazy Horse Memorial Foundation and the University of South Dakota, are as follows:

- Applicants must be 18-21 years of age when the program commences.
- Applicants must possess a high school diploma (Regular Curriculum) or GED before the program commences with a cumulative grade point average or equivalent of 2.00
- ACT or SAT scores are required at the time of application. The minimum composite ACT score is 21; the minimum SAT score is 990 for admission. ACT scores below 21 and SAT scores below 990 may be considered for provisional acceptance.
- Preference is extended to enrolled members of federally recognized tribes but the University is open to all qualified students.
- Applicants must possess a need for the curriculum offered. For example, transfer students who have already successfully completed equivalent college courses are not eligible.
- Completion of a written exercise on why the applicant is interested in the program.
- Applicants must complete a telephone interview with the selection committee.
- All applicants must complete the admission application and provide accompanying required materials by **March 1, 2012**. Applicants chosen for admission must submit final high school transcripts by June 1, 2012. (SAT or ACT scores must be submitted with application)

APPLICATION REQUIREMENTS:

A complete application package includes the following:

1. Completed application form. (Download a copy of the application at <http://www.usd.edu/summer-school/crazy-horse-application.cfm>.) You may complete it online and print it out, and mail it or submit the application to cde@usd.edu. Receipt via e-mail will be recognized as signature.
2. Personal statement of your reasons for desiring to attend the summer program at Crazy Horse Memorial.
3. Proof of membership in federally-recognized tribe for preference consideration.
4. High school transcript and official college transcripts if previously attended college. Applicants **must** have successfully completed high school (Regular Curriculum) or have completed a GED to be eligible to begin the program. Official high school transcripts verifying successful completion are required to be submitted to USD by **June 1, 2012**. An unofficial high school transcript is acceptable to attach to this application.
5. ACT or SAT scores and subscores are required. Scores must be submitted with the application. A minimum composite ACT score of 21 is required; or a 990 SAT score is required. ACT scores below 21 and SAT scores below 990 may be considered for provisional acceptance.
6. Two (2) letters of recommendation. Letters should be written by those familiar with your high school work or, if you have been out of school for more than two years, by people familiar with your performance in the workplace.
7. Agreement to the **Rules of Conduct** for the Summer Program. (Attached).
8. Students will be contacted if they are chosen for a telephone interview.

Incomplete applications will not be considered, so you should be sure that you have submitted all of the necessary documents.

A selection committee comprised of representatives from both the University of South Dakota and The Crazy Horse Memorial Foundation will review all applications in March, 2012. Up to **thirty two** qualified students and five alternates will be chosen. All students will be notified in writing and by e-mail or telephone of their status.

Decisions will be finalized by April 20, 2012.

Not Required now, but Required by June 1, 2012 if accepted to the program:

- Official high school transcript or GED verification. If previously attended college, official transcript of college work. Official means the transcript must be sent directly from the high school, GED office or College to the University of South Dakota. The student may hand deliver if envelope is sealed. A 2.00 GPA is required.
- Proof of Tribal Membership.
- Proof of Immunizations. (Measles, Mumps, Rubella; Hepatitis B immunization & Hepatitis B titer; Varicella/Chicken Pox immunity; DTP/Tdap; Polio; TB Skin Tests or QFT-G Blood Test) by June 1, 2012.
- Proof of Medical Insurance and copy of insurance card and ID# by June 1, 2012.
- Submission of Emergency Contact Information.
- Medical Prescriptions to assure adequate medication over the 8 1/2 week program.
- Recommitment to agree to Rules of Conduct signed statement on or before June 9, 2012.
- Signed Computer Use Policy Statement on or before June 9, 2012.
- Payment of \$50.00 Deposit on or before June 9, 2012 - can pay at check in on June 9th.
