# Get a Head Start and Save with Your First Day Access Materials

University of South Dakota offers a First Day Access (Inclusive Access) program for students who have enrolled in their online dual credit courses.

Through FDA, students gain automatic access to discounted digital, e-Material, such as workbooks, e-Texts, simulations and more!

Digital access will be available for students by the first day of class, and the FDA cost automatically added as a line item charge on a student's university bill. If an optional loose-leaf print copy is available, this would be a separate purchase made by a student.

### How to Utilize FDA

A student can access their material through USD's LMS platform, D2L, unless their instructor tells them otherwise. Access information is listed in the student's USD online bookstore eLibrary account. [Learn More.](#)

### Opting Out

A student can choose to opt-out of the FDA material before the deadline through their USD online bookstore eLibrary account. Once a student opts-out, the business office will process the opt-out and refund the student's university account. If a student needs to opt-back in to utilize their FDA material, they can do so through their eLibrary **but must opt-in before the FDA deadline**. The FDA deadline is listed in a student's eLibrary account. If a student does not opt-out by the deadline, the FDA cost will be a line item charge on the student's university bill.
