- 1) Complete a graduate school application through [GradCAS](#) and upload accompanying information (scores for select tests may be required).
- 2) You will receive notification of acceptance/denial in a formal letter.
- 3) If accepted, consult with an advisor.
- 4) Register for classes.

NON-DEGREE SEEKING STUDENTS

- 1) Students who want to enroll in one class;
- 2) Are not pursuing a degree & do not desire financial aid; or
- 3) Wish to enroll in a course now and apply to a program later;

APPLICATION:

APPLICATION FEE:

An application fee of \$35.00 USD must accompany each application for admission, it cannot be waived or deferred and is not refundable.

TRANSCRIPTS:

Provide official transcripts from each college or university attended. Transcripts must be sent directly from the institution to Graduate Admissions. Graduates and previous students of USD or any of the six South Dakota public universities do not need to provide transcripts. USD can access all South Dakota Board of Regents transcripts.

ADMISSION TEST SCORES:

If test scores are required, standardized test scores should be sent directly to grad.docs@usd.edu or Graduate Admissions, University of South Dakota, from the test publisher's authorized representative. **Check with your enrollment coordinator for GRE/GMAT requirements, as some may programs are waiving the admission tests for upcoming semesters.**

LETTERS OF RECOMMENDATION:

All letters of recommendations should be requested via GradCAS during the application process. The recommender will use the CAS Evaluator Portal to submit their recommendation.

STATEMENT OF PURPOSE:

Applicants are encouraged to provide information about their reason for pursuing graduate studies, interest in research or creative activity relevant to their proposed graduate program, and goals for the future. Not all graduate programs require a formal statement of purpose and instead, require supplemental information. The statement of purpose and supplemental information should be submitted through GradCAS.

DROPPING AND WITHDRAWING

WITHDRAWAL FROM THE UNIVERSITY

An undergraduate student is considered withdrawing from the university if they terminate enrollment in ALL courses from any South Dakota state university. If the student is taking only one course and drops that course, this is a withdrawal which means zero credits for the semester remain.

To withdraw from USD, use the withdrawal form located on the [Withdrawal and Refunds](#) page. Graduate students may use this form to withdraw from all classes, but do not withdraw from the university. All withdrawals must be signed, dated, and delivered to USD, Financial Aid Counselor, Belbas Center, Room 206, Vermillion SD 57069, or faxed to 605-677-5238. A phone call will not be sufficient. **Leaving courses without completing the withdrawal or drop paperwork could result in a failing grade, and you will be responsible for the payment of tuition and fees.**

DROPPED COURSE

A course is considered dropped if a student terminates enrollment in that course but continues to be actively enrolled in at least one other course with any South Dakota state university during the semester. To drop one or more courses (but not all courses), students use Self-Service Registration.

Financial aid recipients should contact the Financial Aid office at 605-658-6250 prior to completing paperwork to determine the effects of the drop or withdrawal on their financial aid. A refund and/or repayment to a specific financial aid program may be required.

BILLING INFORMATION

SDEPAY & FACTS PAYMENT PLAN

Your tuition and fee bill will be available on SDePay. You will not receive a paper billing statement. An email will be sent from SDePay to your official USD email address and your authorized payer's email address announcing the billing statement is ready to be viewed and paid. An email will be sent each time a new tuition and fee statement is generated. You may view your account balance at any time through SDePay. The due date for your bill will appear on your current billing statement.

PROCTOR & EXAM INFORMATION

Many courses require students to take assessments in the presence of a proctor, in a professional setting, not in a private home. If your course requires this, it will be clearly stated in the syllabus. Proctored tests taken at facilities other than USD may be subject to a fee.

SELECTING A PROCTOR

All proctors must be currently employed as a professional testing center, librarian, full time instructor at a college or university, superintendent or school principal, 9-12 grade teacher or guidance counselors. Students in the armed forces on active duty, may utilize a testing center on a base. If a testing center is not available due to deployment overseas, an higher ranked officer is also permissible to proctor an exam.

Students in Pierre, Rapid City, Sioux Falls and surrounding area:

Students testing at testing centers below do not need to fill out a proctor form, but do need to notify the USD Testing Center to identify a testing location they plan to use before each semester and are responsible for scheduling appointments.

Students testing anywhere else:

Students must submit the proctor form within in the first two weeks of class to the USD Testing Center and are responsible for scheduling appointments. Policies and the proctor form can be found at on the [Testing Center](#) website.

HOW TO SCHEDULE AN APPOINTMENT

Appointments must be made a minimum of 24 hours prior to the date/time you would like to test. Allow extra time for midterms and finals.
