SOCW 482 provides undergraduate students introductory curriculum for working in the child welfare setting. SOCW 582 was designed and approved as a dual listed course with SOCW 482. However, the curriculum in SOCW 582 provides a master level perspective that includes higher level knowledge, critical thinking, appraisal, and skills than the undergraduate course. A course deletion request has been submitted to delete SOCW 582. This new course will ensure clear distinction between the undergraduate and graduate level courses. These courses will no longer be dual listed.
