SOCW 486 provides undergraduate students introductory curriculum to work with Native families. SOCW 586 was designed and approved as a dual listed course with SOCW 486. However, the curriculum in SOCW 586 provides a master level perspective that includes higher level knowledge, critical thinking, appraisal, and skills than the undergraduate course. A course deletion request has been submitted to delete SOCW 586. This new course will ensure clear distinction between the undergraduate and graduate level courses. These courses will no longer be dual listed.
