7. Explanation of the Change:

Currently, the secondary education programs, including PE, are identified as separate programs. Several of the programs (Spanish education, Biology education, Math education, and PE) have low enrollment numbers, while English Education and History Education tend to be more robust in terms of enrollment. These programs have a core of 40 hours that are taken by all education majors, and a content specific series of courses that are taken with non-education in their respective disciplines. The only unique course for the secondary programs is the content specific pedagogy course(s) (SEED 413, Seed 415, SEED 424, SEED 418, PE 330, PE 480). When taken individually, PE, Math and Biology are low enrolled, however taken as a group, the secondary majors has sufficient enrollment to be viable. Discontinuing these programs could result in a loss of students as they may choose to go to another institution to earn their desired degree.
