Course Description
U.S. Health Services Systems, HSAD 710, surveys the major components and organizational interrelationships of the U.S. health services delivery system across the continuum of care. Students will gain a broad understanding of the historical evolution of the health services delivery system as well as contemporary health reform initiatives which aim to reduce national health services expenditures and improve organizational performance.

Course Description for HSAD 710: Contemporary Issues in Health Services Administration
This course explores practices of exceptional leaders in the health care field. Students will discover, explore, and assess contemporary issues in health care and consider the business and social forces that are shaping the need for creative and revolutionary approaches to health care, domestically and internationally. Students will evaluate ethical principles, personal and company values, and socially responsible management practices in the interests of responsible and feasible health care delivery.
