Provide explanation of differences between proposed course and existing system catalog courses below:

The proposed course differs from HSAD 325 in content and scope. Some of the material from HSAD 325 has been moved into the HSAD 305 course to help accommodate the consolidation of the long-term classes into two courses. HSAD 459/559 will add additional content on the types of organizational options available for long-term care. These are explored in depth including their impact on staffing implications, health care costs, and quality of treatment. HSAD 460/560 is devoted more to management and administrative functions. It also covers policy and legal regulations for long-term care organizations as well as financial funding models. The proposed course does not cover those topics.
