Course Description

Advanced Health Care Management examines the daily operations of health care organizations. This course addresses governance, line management, staff support, and the implementation of business strategies. The course focuses on the effective management of health care professionals and identifies unique human resource elements in health care organizations. This class is suitable for clinicians interested in basic management principles.

This course provides a system's perspective of health services administration by integrating concepts across all functional business areas. Students learn to utilize effective decision making techniques in identifying and solving resource problems. The course develops skills in defining strategic and operational management problems and understanding the complex nature of management decisions. The course explores recent trends, issues, and relevant regulatory standards and change efforts including risk assessment that impact resource management in health services delivery.
