Students must have a minimum CGPA of 2.6 to co-register for EDFN 338, SEED 296 and TET 200, and a CGPA of 2.7 to be eligible to apply for Teacher Education admission. Students must have a score of 150-Math, 156-Reading, 162-Writing in the 3 areas of the PRAXIS CORE prior to admission (ets.org). Students completing the BSED in English Education are not required to have a minor, but may choose to do so. The Bachelor's degree is also available through the College of Arts and Sciences. A minor is required for the BS/BA degree. All teacher certification requirements must be completed including meeting the required scores on the PRAXIS CORE, Content Test, and PLT.
