USD Nursing Laptop Requirement (Effective Fall 2015 admission – updated for Spring 2019)

Every student is required to own and maintain a laptop while enrolled in the nursing program at the USD Department of Nursing. Every student must also have access to a printer and scanner. Every class day requires use of a personal laptop. Students must download and utilize online materials that require significant computer memory, hardware and software. All exams are taken on a secured classroom network and again require significant hardware and software requirements.

Students have the option of purchasing one of the following:

Purchasing Option 1) A *business class* type of laptop is recommended by USD Department of Nursing. Previously several Fujitsu and HP models were recommended at varying prices; currently Lenovo and HP Laptops are recommended. A link is provided to view each laptop, learn more about its capabilities, find out the prices of each model, and then purchase the laptop. All recommended laptops in this link are equipped with the recommended hardware and run the required software, etc. Maintenance, warranties, and IT Tech support will be provided at a high level for these selected models (See below table and link).

Purchasing Option 2) A *personal consumer* model laptop from the store of personal choice. Students who choose this option would be required to make sure all required hardware requirements are met in order to run the required software and make sure the software is loaded onto the laptop prior to the program starting. The student will be responsible for all maintenance, repairs, etc. These students will have very limited (if any) IT support available and will be responsible to have a back-up plan should his/her laptop not function correctly during an exam. All Apple laptops are strongly discouraged due to significant incompatibilities with required software resources and network servers. (See below table).
