- Ability to recruit volunteers and organizations to partner in each community
- Complete a USD W-9 Form for Stipend Payments

The Oyate` Wicha`ho Unki` project coordinators, Wayne Weston and Jim Warne will provide orientation training for the community reps.

Twelve Communities are included for this project: Pine Ridge, Rosebud, Cheyenne River, Standing Rock, Lower Brule, Yankton, Sisseton Wahpeton, Flandreau, Crow Creek, Sioux Falls, Pierre and Rapid City.
